Tax Accounts

The deadline for a 10% discount off residential property taxes if the account is paid in full is extended to May 1, 2020. The deadline date for seniors is extended to July 31, 2020. Council has waived the 4.5% interest that would normally be applied June 30, 2020 on taxes for the 2020 taxation year.
