

Welcome Participants to the Annual Dunville Lions Club/Town of Placentia Santa Claus Parade

Below are our rules to help ensure we have another successful parade....

1. There is **only ONE Santa Claus** in the Parade and he is in his sleigh at the end of the Parade!
2. The parade starts at 1:00PM. You must be at the designated marshaling area (CNA) no later than 12:00. Marshalls will assign you to one of three lines.
3. Judging will take place prior to the completion of the parade and be announced in the Town Square immediately following the Parade.
4. Children should not be transported to or from the Parade on open roads on the back of Parade floats.
5. All participants are responsible for ensuring that the design and operation of their Entry is safe and reliable. Safety of participants and the general public is a top priority. Safety is the ultimate responsibility of each individual entry. Entries must comply with all safety, government regulations, codes and manufacturer's recommendations.
6. Your entry must always maintain a forward motion unless you are asked to stop by a Parade Marshall. All entries must keep pace with the parade to prevent large gaps between entries. It is recommended that your speed not exceed 10km/hour or four (4) car lengths.
7. Hard candies should not be thrown from floats, although you are permitted to hand them out.
8. Snowballs (if they exist) should not be thrown at the public from floats.
9. No one should have their feet dangling over the sides of floats. If you think what you're doing may be dangerous, it probably is. Remember there are hundreds of children around.
10. Please ensure that you take all garbage with you. Please don't leave any garbage behind, including livestock droppings, i.e. horses, donkeys, reindeer etc.!
11. Alcoholic beverages and smoking are forbidden on any entry. Any participant suspected of being under the influence will be removed from the parade.
