Accepted Items Included:

- Mattresses
- Furniture
- Bathroom fixtures
- Carpet tied in rolls (less than 1.5 m, less than 22 kg)
- Tree limbs tied in bundles (less than 1.5m and 22kg)
- Glass, secured and marked

Accepted Items Included:

- Refrigerators, washers, dryers, and additional household appliances
- Removable car parts (less than 22kg, all fluids such as oil, lubricants and antifreezes must be removed prior to collection)
- Iron
- White Metals

Items NOT Included:

- Brick
- Electronics
- Concrete
- Earthen materials including stumps and large trees
- Roof shingles
- Tires
- Cardboard or paper
- Liquids
- Fishing Nets
- Recyclables in blue bags
- Animal Carcasses.
- Household Hazardous waste (paint, chemicals, etc.)
- Car wrecks and removable car parts that are greater than 22 kg,
- Car chassis or frames
- Car wrecks and removable car parts that do not have all fluids such as oil, lubricants and antifreezes removed.
- Creosote blocks
